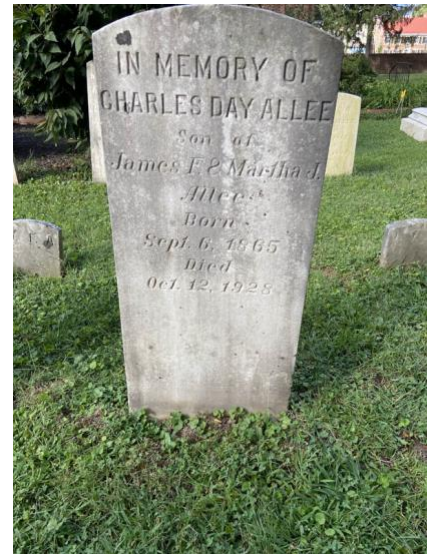

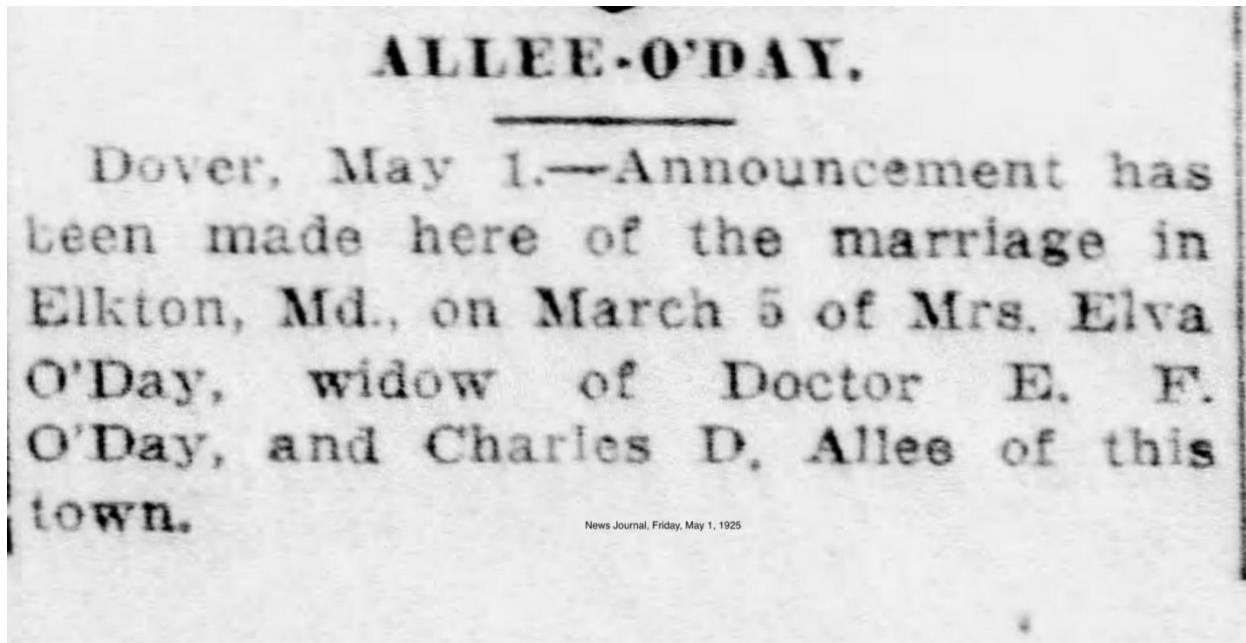

DOVER, May 14—(Special).—With the Rev. William F. Edge, pastor of Peoples Congregational-Christian Church, officiating, funeral services will be held for Mrs. Elva M. Allee, 75, at 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon at her late residence, 129 South State Street. Burial will be in Od Fellows' Cemetery, Camden.

Mrs. Allee, who died Wednesday night, was the widow of Charles D. Allee. She leaves two sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth R. Muncey, Camden, and Mrs. Sarah C. Paradee, Magnolia, and a niece, Mrs. Marian Patchell, Newark.

Niece of Senator Allee

Born Lois Allee, Mrs. Williams is the daughter of the late Charles Day Allee, and Mrs. Allee, who now resides at Port Royal, Va. She came to Washington more than two decades ago with her late husband, Ashby Williams, a prominent attorney.

She comes from a family that is no newcomer to Washington society circles. Her uncle, the late Senator J. Frank Allee, represented Delaware in the United States Senate during the period just after the turn of the century. He was a "Bull Moose" follower of President Theodore Roosevelt, and is a well remembered figure in the capital.

Mrs. Williams is an active member of the Delaware State Society in Washington and when it comes to protocol for a visit of Delaware royalty, such as Cherry Blossom Princess Lois Alava, to the capital, the society has an able social arbiter on hand.
