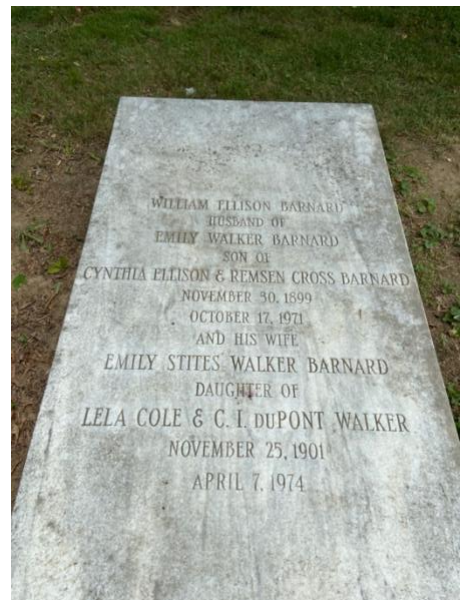

DOVER—William Ellison Barnard, 71, of 129 N. State St., died in Kent General Hospital yesterday, after a long illness.

Mr. Barnard was in Camden. He was a retired general manager and secretary of the Delaware Motor Transport Association. He was a member of Christ Episcopal Church in Dover where he was a longtime vestryman. He was a member of the Historical Society of Delaware, the Friends of Old Dover, and Walter L. Fox Post, American Legion.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Emily Walker Barnard, and a sister, Miss Margaret Barnard of Miami.

Services will be at Christ Episcopal Church Wednesday afternoon at 2. Interment will be in the church cemetery.
