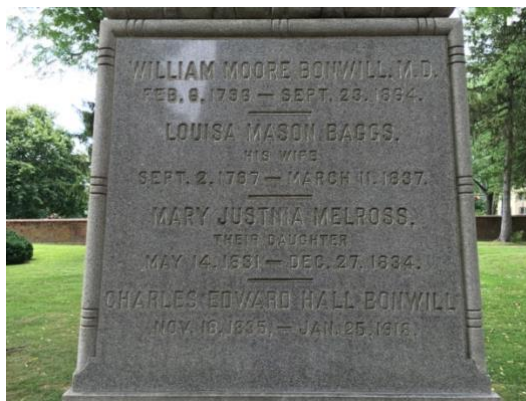

BONWILL MONUMENT: This obelisk is directly in front of the church; installation date unknown. Death dates begin with Louisa Mason Baggs Bonwill, wife of Dr. William Moore Bonwill, in 1837. Three sides have inscriptions. The headstones on each side of the monument have initials. G11 p.2

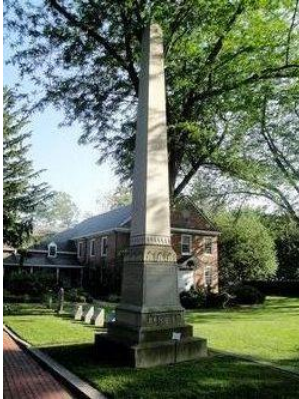

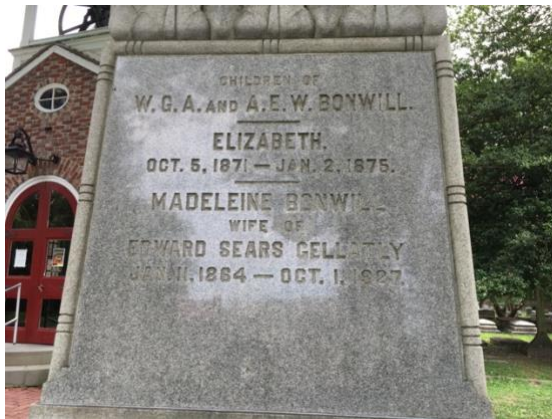

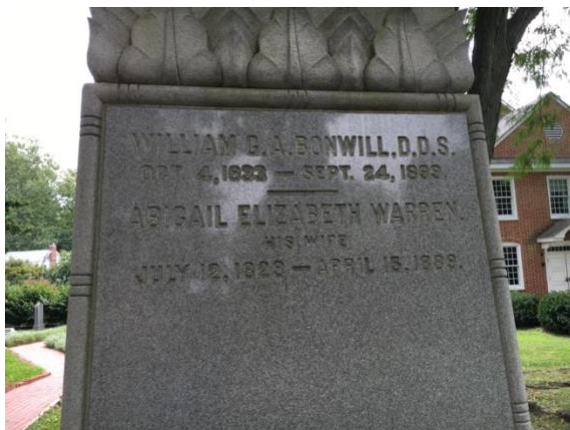
