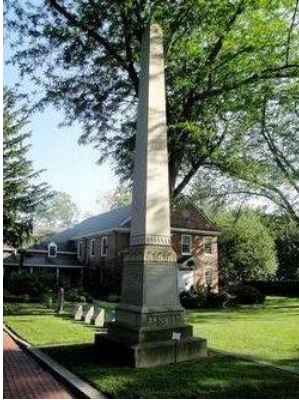

BONWILL MONUMENT: This obelisk is directly in front of the church; installation date unknown. 300 G 12 B p. 2
 Death dates begin with Louisa Mason Baggs Bonwill, wife of Dr. William Moore Bonwill, in 1837. Three sides have inscriptions. The headstones on each side of the monument have initials.

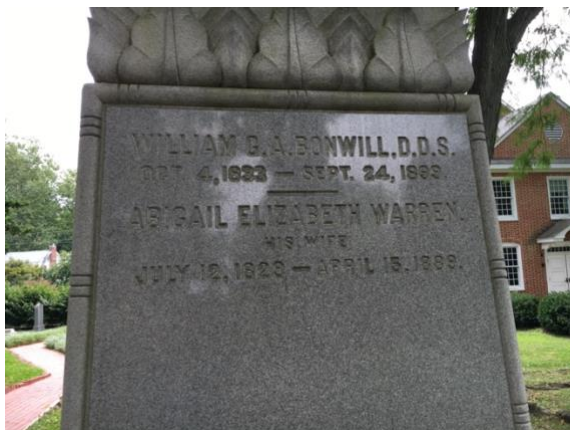
