**WILLIAMSBURG** — Virginia Corkran Bowdle, a retired school cafeteria manager, died at her home Wednesday morning, Dec. 27, 1989. She was 78.

Born on Nov. 9, 1911 near Williamsburg, she was the daughter of the late Lee and Nellie Stevens Corkran.

Employed by the Dorchester County Board of Education for 40 years, she had been cafeteria manager at both Hurlock Elementary and Hurlock High School. She was a member of the Williamsburg United Methodist Church and since its closing had been a member of the Wesley United Methodist Church in Hurlock.

Her husband, Thomas W. Bowdle, died Sept. 12, 1981.

Mrs. Bowdle is survived by two daughters, Shirley B. Truitt of Waleysville, Md., and Jean Bramble of Hurlock; one son, Richard Bowdle of Federalsburg; one sister, Rachel Grimes of Federalsburg; two brothers, Howard H. Corkran of Luther-ville, and John Mace Corkran of Manchester, Md.; seven grand-
