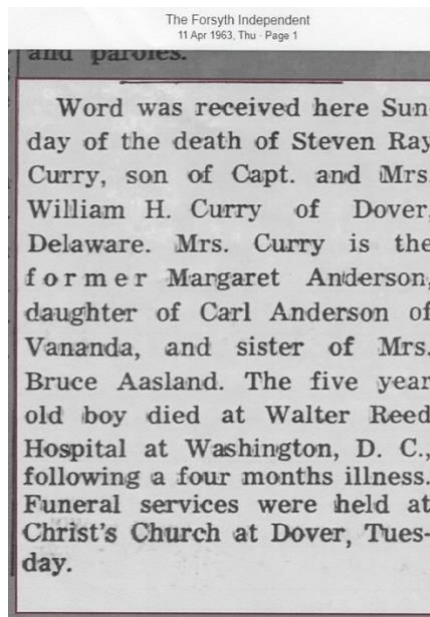

Both parents were born and raised in Montana. Capt. Curry joined the Air Force and they were stationed in Dover at the time of Steven's death at Walter Reed Hospital in Washington, D.C.
