Mrs. Hammond Rites Planned

Civic Leader of Dover Played Prominent Part In Suffrage Movement

DOVER, Nov. 23—(Special).—Funeral services for Mrs. Ethel Millington Hammond, 61 years old, who died suddenly at her home here, Tuesday night, will be held at 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon in Christ P. E. Church.

The Rev. Paul A. Kellogg, rector, will officiate. Interment will be in Christ Churchyard. Friends may call at the Ferguson and Hayes Funeral Home tonight.

Mrs. Hammond was a pioneer in the women's suffrage movement in this state, an organizer of the former Dover soldiers' center which was the forerunner of the Dover U. S. O., a Red Cross Gray Lady, and a lifelong member of Christ Church. She lived at 208 North State Street.

A native of Dover, Mrs. Hammond was the daughter of the late George and Ida M. Millington. Her father was the proprietor of the former Capitol Hotel on The Dover Green.

Surviving are four sons, Rosewell Hammond, Jr., George M. Hammond, Philadelphia, Anthony Hammond and Francis J. Hammond, Dover; a daughter, Miss Hope Hammond, Dover; a sister, Mrs. Marguerite Donellan, Philadelphia, and a brother, George P. Millington, Philadelphia.
