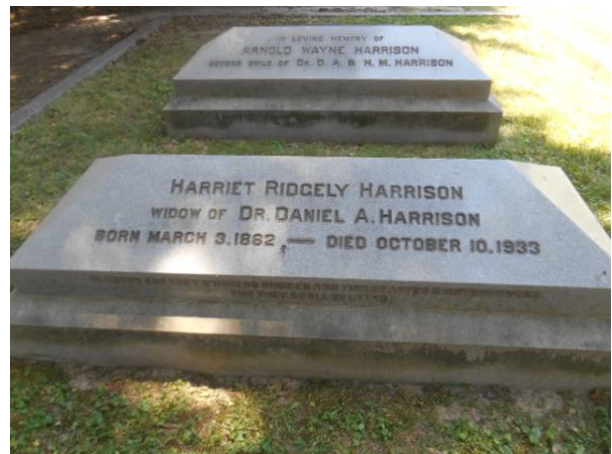

**MRS. D. A. HARRISON DIES**

DOVER, Del., Oct. 10 —(Special).—The funeral of Mrs. D. A. Harrison, widow of Dr. Daniel A. Harrison and sister of Henry Ridgely, of Dover, who died at her home, White Stone, Long Island, will be held at 12 o'clock tomorrow noon at Christ P. E. Church and interment made in the adjoining cemetery. She was a daughter of the late Edward Ridgely, an attorney. She was born in Dover and lived here until her marriage.
