LAURA BETH MOYER, 16, of Dover, died Wednesday at Kent General Hospital, of wounds from a self-inflicted gunshot wound Tuesday at Dover High School.

Laura, an honor-roll student, was president of the junior class and president of the student council.

She was active in many school activities, wrote for an underground newspaper, and was a

member of the Photography Club and Act I Players. She enjoyed acting and directing plays at the school.

In her freshman year, Laura played Blitzen the reindeer in "The Mouse that Was Stirring," for a series of holiday plays for children at Dover High School, her sister, Jennifer Ann Moyer said Wednesday. She played the mayor in "Richard III" during her sophomore year and was to play the lead role in an upcoming school production.

She was also a member of Dover Thespian Society. She was a supporter of the Dover Art League, and enjoyed sketching pen and ink drawings, her mother, Beverly A. Sisson of Dover, said Wednesday. She loved music and played the guitar.

She was a member of Christ Episcopal Church, Dover.

Besides her mother, Laura is survived by her father, William F. Moyer of Dover; a sister, Jennifer Ann Moyer of Dover; and her maternal grandparents, Norris and June Benson of Laurel.

A service will be at 11 a.m. Saturday at Christ Episcopal Church, State and Water streets, Dover, with burial in the adjoining cemetery. Family and friends may call from 7 to 9 p.m. Friday at Faries Funeral Home, 1250 S. Governors Ave., Dover.
