CALEB S. PENNEWILL EXPIRES AT DOVER

Well Known Banker, Business Man and Democrat Dies at Age of 86

ONCE NOMINATED BY PARTY FOR GOVERNOR

Special to THE EVENING JOURNAL.
 DOVER, Aug. 22.—Caleb Simeon Pennewill, one of the best-known citizens of lower Delaware, died at his home late last evening, aged 86 years. His death, while not sudden, came as a surprise to many people.

Mr. Pennewill for many years was identified with the business and political life of Delaware. He was elected a member of the House of the Delaware Legislature in 1858 and in 1878 was elected for four years as a member of the State Senate.

In 1904 he was the Democratic candidate for governor and was defeated by the late Preston Lea.

For many years he was a director of the Farmers' Bank of Delaware, and in 1904 at the death of Dr. Henry Ridgely, who had been president of the bank for many years, he was elected president of the bank. He served in that capacity until January last, when he declined re-election and Henry Ridgely was elected to succeed him.

In business life he was practically the head for many years of the well-known lumber firm of Hazel and Pennewill of this town. He is survived by one child, Mrs. Dr. Beulah Lewis, of Harrington. Funeral services will be held from his late residence Saturday afternoon at 1.30 o'clock with interment in Christ P. E. Church yard in the Pennewill family lot.

Pennewill* are held and firmly bound to the State of Delaware, in the sum of two hundred dollars, lawful money of the said State, to be paid to the said State of Delaware; to which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and each of us, jointly and severally, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated this *29th* day of *January* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-*seven*.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if *C. S. Pennewill* aforesaid, and *Emily Raughley* may lawfully unite themselves in marriage, and if there be no legal objection to celebrating the rites of marriage between them, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to be and remain in force.
