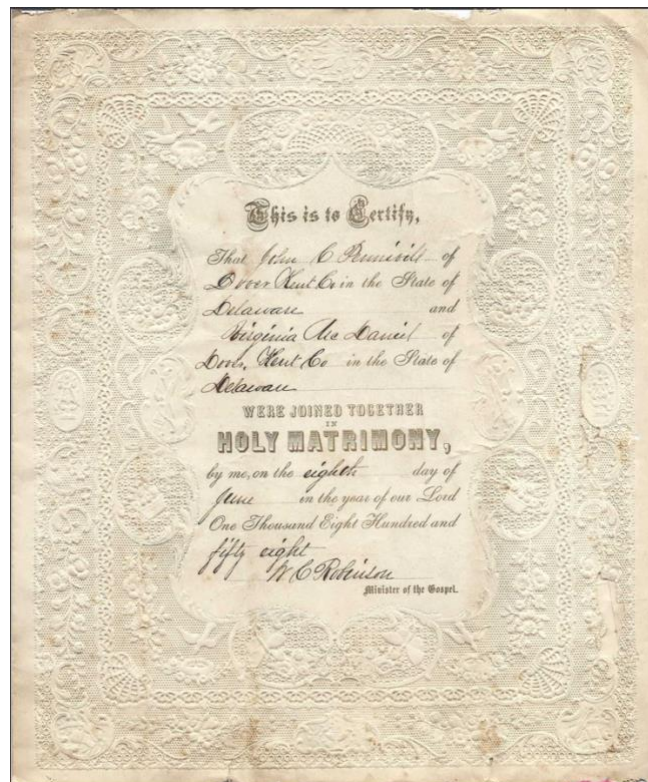

JOHN C. PENNEWILL DEAD.

Death of a Prominent Kent Countain Last Thursday Morning at Dover.

Special Correspondence of Gazette and Journal

Dover, May 21.—John C. Pennewill, a leading citizen and prominent Democrat, died this morning, aged 66 years.

He was born in Dover and had lived here almost all his life. He had filled many positions of public trust, among which were Levy Court commissioner, sheriff of Kent county in 1862, clerk of the Senate, deputy register of wills under Moses Harrington, register of wills for two terms, postmaster during President Cleveland's first term and deputy register of wills under F. T. Cooper. He had enjoyed good health until about four months ago, when he was attacked by a complication of diseases.

He leaves eight children, as follows: Mrs. R. R. Kenney, Mrs. William T. Smithers, William Pennewill and Misses Fannie and Emma Pennewill of this town, John and Arthur Pennewill of Wilmington and Robert O, Pennewill of Illinois.
