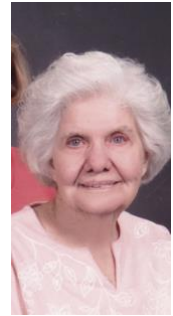

Jewell "Judy" T. Smith of Dover passed away Tuesday, May 13, 2014 at home. She was 90. Mrs. Smith was born November 27, 1923 in Franklin County, Illinois to the late Benjiman F.
