E. Richmond Steele Jr., 76

DOVER - E. Richmond Steele Jr. of Huntly Circle, Dover, died of heart failure Sunday, March 28, 1993, in Kent General Hospital. He was 76.

Mr. Steele was born in Jefferson Hospital, Philadelphia, the son of the late Dr. Ernest R. Steele and Margaret Hammond Steele. He had lived his whole life in Dover.

He was an alummi of St. Andrews School, Middletown, and Princeton University, Princeton, N.J. After graduation from Princeton, he volunteered for service in the U.S. Army, during which he served in Africa and Italy. After five years of military service, he left the service with the rank of major.

He was a vice president and regional manager of Bank of Delaware, retiring in 1987, after 34 years of service. He was a graduate of The Stonier Graduate School of Banking, Rutgers University, New Brunswick, N.J., and was one of the founders and first president of Kent County Chapter of American Institute of Banking, He was also a former president of the Delaware Bankers Association.

He was a charter member of the Golden Opportunity Center, which later became Kent-Sussex Industries, and served until 1992

He was a former board member of the Kent County Heart Association, the United Way and the Cancer Society.

He recently retired as first vice chairman of the Board of Directors of Kent General Foundation of the Kent General Hospital.

Mr. Steele was a lifelong member and former Treasurer of the Maple Dale County Club and was a member of the Camden-Wyoming Rotary Club.

He was a former vestryman and Warden of Christ Episcopal Church, Dover, and was serving as trustee for the Episcopal Diocese of Delaware.

His first wife, Ruth Hulett Steele, died in 1960.
