Rebecca Wolcott Terry

On Monday September 13, 1999, Rebecca Wolcott Terry died at Bay Health Medical Center in Dover, DE. Born in Wilmington, DE on May 24, 1916, Mrs. Terry was 83 years old at the time of her death. She was the daughter of Chancellor Josiah Oliver Wolcott and Mary Rebecca Fooks Wolcott of Dover. Her paternal grandparents were James becca Fooks Wolcott of Dover. She was very active in local charities and loved the genealogy and history of Delaware. She was a member of the National Society of Colonial Dames of America, the Friends of old Dover, and a regular hostess of Old Dover Days where she opened her home on The Green to the public for many years. She was a Former Director of the Children's Bureau of Delaware, an Honorary Life Board Member of the Delaware Chapter of the American Red Cross, and a charter member of the Junior Barard of the Kent Red Cross, and a charter member of the Junior Board of the Kent of the Junior Board of the Kent General Hospital. In addition, she was chairman for the Citizens Conference on Social Work Relating to Migrant Workers Problems and a member of the State Building & Grounds Commission.
