DEATH TAKES DAUGHTER OF RECTOR AND WIFE

DOVER, Del., July 17.—Miss Dorothy Thompson, only daughter of the Rev. and Mrs. Benjamin Fish Thompson, rector of Christ P. E. Church, this town, died yesterday afternoon after seven weeks' illness of typhoid fever. Miss Thompson was 20 years of age, and was a general favorite with all who knew her. Her condition last week was considered much better and it was thought by the family and attending physician that she might recover. She grew worse, however, within the past few days. Funeral services will be held in Christ P. E. Church tomorrow at 1.30 o'clock, with interment in Christ P. E. Cemetery adjoining.
