Mrs. Grace L. Thompson, 71, was buried today in Christ Church Cemetery, Dover, Del., following private services at the church.

Mrs. Thompson, the former Grace Lynam, died Tuesday at her home, 7 E. Roland Road, Parkside. She was the widow of Bertrick Thompson, a former ship captain for the Sun Oil Company.

She was a retired school teacher and librarian. She was a graduate of Syracuse University, Syracuse, N.Y., and had taught in New York, Connecticut and Massachusetts.

She was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church and was an active member of its Women's Guild. They had lived in the Chester area about 25 years.

She is survived by a brother, Lynn S. Lynam of Buffalo, N.Y.
