Dover, Jan. 4.—Saturday evening at Christ Church Chapel, Philadelphia, at 8 o'clock William Heyl Thompson, of Dover, and Miss Jane Eleanor Brown, of Philadelphia, were married by Rev. Benjamin F. Thompson, rector of Christ P. E. Church, Dover, father of the groom, assisted by the vicar of the chapel, Rev. R. L. Nisbett.

The brother of the groom, J. Stockett Thompson, was best man and the mother of the bride, Mrs. Blanche Baird Brown, of Philadelphia, stood near the bride.
