Christopher Edward Wilson

Chris Wilson, 19, of Smyrna, DE, died on Thursday, June 8, 2000.

Chris was born in 1981 in Alabaster, AL. He grew up in the neighborhood of Woodbrook in South Dover and on his family's farm in Smyrna. Chris studied and played football and lacrosse at St. Andrew's School in Middletown, and graduated there in 1999. A loving brother and son, Chris spent a good deal of his life in public service. At age 13, Chris volunteered at the Delaware Agricultural Museum, helping facilitate summer programs for small children. Each summer since 1996, Chris served as a counselor at Camp Arrowhead - a wilderness camp for children in Lewes sponsored by the Episcopal Diocese of Delaware. He was also a member of Christ Church in Dover, and often served as an acolyte. Chris was a lover of music - he played jazz trumpet at St. Andrews. He also learned to love the sea. Chris spent the last year of his life sailing in Trinidad, Venezuela and the eastern Caribbean with his Uncle Jeff. Chris was scheduled to start his freshman year at Dickinson College in Carlisle, PA this fall. Dedicated to serving children, Chris planned to study history in preparation for a career as a teacher. He will be sorely missed by all those who knew him and the contents of his heart.

Chris is survived by his parents, Ted and Juanita Wilson of Smyrna, DE; his brother, Josh Wilson of Chicago, IL; his 2 grandmothers, Hilda Krupka of Hartly, DE and Marion Wilson of Rehoboth, DE; and numerous uncles, aunts and cousins. Chris was also the grandson of Edward S. Wilson, Jr. formerly of Smyrna and Rehoboth, DE.

A service will be held 3:30 pm Monday, June 12 in Christ Episcopal Church, State & Water Sts., Dover, DE. The family will greet friends and family after the service on the church grounds.
