Dover, Oct. 17 -- Harry C. Walker secretary and treasurer of the Farmers and Merchants Building and Loan Association, died at his residence on King street, yesterday morning, after an illness of several weeks. He was 44 years of age. He leaves a widow, who was Miss Amy Ford, sister of Harry F. Ford, proprietor of the Bayard House. They had been married but little over two years. Funeral services will be held from his late residence Wednesday afternoon, with interment in Christ P.E. cemetery.

1900 Census: Henry was a boarder with John M. and Sallie A. Ford. Amy Ford was also living in the boarding house, and they were married in 1901.
