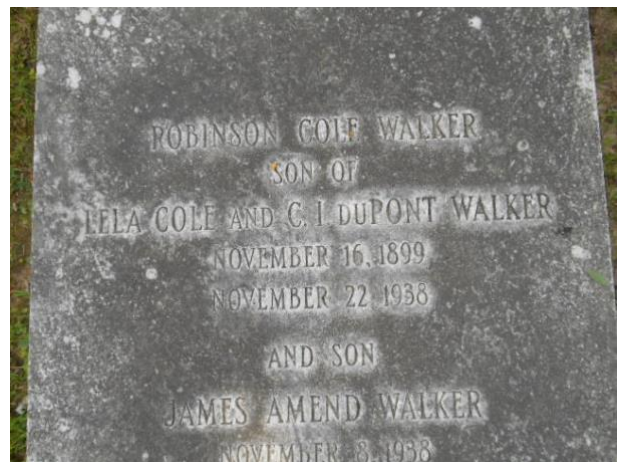

ROBINSON C. WALKER SUCCUMBS AT DOVER

DOVER, Nov. 22—Robinson C. Walker, 39, son of Mrs. duPont Walker and the late duPont Walker, died at his home here tonight after a long illness. He was a former manager of the Delaware Index. In addition to his mother, he is survived by his wife, the former Marian Amend of near Pittsburgh, and a sister, Mrs. Emily Walker Barnard of Chicago.

He was a nephew of Mrs. Harry A. Richardson of Dover, widow of a former U. S. Senator from Delaware. Funeral arrangements will be announced later.
