Bishop's in-law dies in England

George Augustus Wall, 83, father of Mrs. J. Brooke Mosley of Wilmington, died Tuesday at the home of his other daughter, Mrs. William Clegg, Carlisle, England.

Mr. Wall had lived since 1966 with his daughter and son-in-law, the Rt. Rev. J. Brooke Mosley, bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Delaware, at 14 Wood Road.

Mr. Wall was born in London, England, and moved to the United States in 1920. He was manager-owner of the Triangle Cleaning and Dying Establishment in Jenkintown, Pa. for many years. He retired to Gulfport, Fla., then moved to Yarmouth, Nova Scotia, in 1964. His wife, Mrs. Miriam Dixson Wall, died in Yarmouth in 1966.

Mr. Wall was a vestryman of St. Anne's Episcopal Church in Abington, Pa.; a Mason, a co-founder of the Artisans in Jenkintown and a Rotarian.

In addition to his two daughters, he is survived by three grandchildren in the United States and three in England; a brother and four sisters in England.

Mr. Wall's ashes will be buried in mid-September in Christ Churchyard, Dover, Del. The funeral service was in Carlisle.

I, George Augustus Wall, aged 23 years, occupation conductor, do declare on oath that my personal description is: Color white, complexion light, height 2 feet 11 inches, weight 165 pounds, color of hair light, color of eyes dark grey, other visible distinctive marks none.

I was born in London England on the 24 day of June anno Domini 1885; I now reside at 2327 W. Sargeant St Philadelphia, Pa. I emigrated to the United States of America from Liverpool England on the vessel Ausitania my last foreign residence was Grays England.

It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Edward VII King of Great Britain and Ireland, of which I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of Philadelphia in the State of Pa on or about the 6 day of November anno Domini 1907. I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein:
