Thomas E. Whalen Rites

DOVER, Nov. 28—(Special).—Funeral services for Thomas E. Whalen, 61, who died of a heart attack at his home in Camden Wednesday morning, will be held from the Torbert Funeral Home, Dover, at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon with interment in Christ Church Yard.

The Rev. Paul A. Kellogg, rector of Christ P. E. Church, and vicar of St. Paul's Chapel, Camden, will officiate at the funeral home. The service at the church yard will be in charge of Union Lodge, No. 7, A. F. and A. M.

Mr. Whalen, a retired Pennsylvania Railroad employe, formerly lived in Mt. Holly, N. J., and New York, but moved to Camden three years ago following his retirement. His only survivor is his widow, Mrs. Elizabeth Whalen.

Mr. Whalen was a member of Mt. Holly Lodge, F. and A. M.; Helena Commandery, Knights Templar, New Jersey, and was a Royal Arch Mason.
