Thomas E. Whalen Rites

Puneral services for Thomas E. Whalen, 61, who died of a heart attack at his home in Camden Wednesday morning, will be held from the Torbert Funeral Home, Dover, at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon with interment in Christ Church Yard.
