WILLIAM N. WHELEN SR., died Wednesday of heart failure at Harrison House of Georgetown. He was 87.

Mr. Whelen, of The Circle, Georgetown, was a stockbroker at Hollowell-Sultz, Burger, Zensk & Kirkland, Philadelphia, for 40 years. After his retirement in 1966, he opened Suplee Mosely Inc., a Georgetown brokerage firm, in 1967.

He was a past president of Georgetown Kiwanis.

Mr. Whelen is survived by a son, William N. Jr. of Georgetown; and three grandchildren.

A memorial service will be at 2 p.m. Friday at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Academy and Pine streets, Georgetown.
