Dr. Henry Wilson Jr. of Dover dies at 76

DOVER — Dr. Henry V.P. Wilson Jr., 76, prominent Dover physician, died Sunday of a heart attack at his home at N. Lockerman St. and Park Dr.

He was born in Chapel Hill, N.C., and graduated from the University of North Carolina and Johns Hopkins School of Medicine. He joined the Kent General Hospital staff as its first chief of surgeons in 1927 and retired from surgery in 1968.

He then joined the medical staff of the State Home at Smyrna, and retired in 1972.

He served 11 years on the University of Delaware Board of Trustees, and on the State Board of Education. He was also a member of the American College of Surgeons and of Christ Episcopal Church, Dover.

He is survived by his wife, Jessie C. Wilson, and a son, Dr. Henry V.P. III of Charlotte, N.C.
