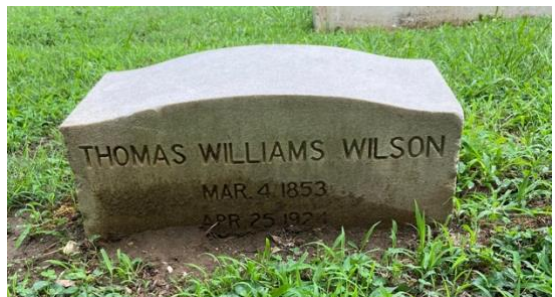

Thomas W. Wilson, father of Thomas W. Wilson, Jr., president of the Wilson-Nash Motors Company in Baltimore, died yesterday at his son's home, after an illness of 10 days, of pneumonia. He was 71 years old. It had been Mr. Wilson's custom to visit Baltimore each winter. His summer home was in Rehoboth. He was a native of Dover, this state.

Another son, Howard M. Wilson, of Boston, Mass., survives him in addition to Thomas W. Wilson, Jr., 2504 Elsinor avenue, Baltimore. Funeral services will be held at 2 P.
