Funeral of Job C. Bartlett.

Funeral services for Job Collins Bartlett, 50 years old, were conducted on Thursday afternoon in Christ Methodist Episcopal Church, Denver, Col. Mr. Bartlett was born in Philadelphia and was a son of Job and Mrs. Abigail Brick Bartlett, members of an old Quaker family. He came to this city in 1881, where he engaged in the stove, range and furnace business in Wood street. On account of failing health he retired about three years ago. He was a member of St. John's lodge 219; Duquesne Commandery 72; Pennsylvania consistory, A. A. S. R., and Syria Temple. Mr. Bartlett is survived by his widow, Mrs. Mary Spain Bartlett.
