Dover councilman Alfred S. Biggs dies

Alfred S. Biggs, long-time Dover councilman, died yesterday in Kent General Hospital, where he was undergoing treatment for a heart attack.


Biggs had nearly 14 years of service on the city council and spent most of his life in Dover. He lived at 420 S. State St. and was a retired plumbing contractor, having his own firm, Alfred S. Biggs & Son Inc.

Dover Mayor Crawford J. Carroll yesterday ordered city flags flown at half mast until after Biggs' funeral.

Biggs, whose age was unknown, was a member of the Robbins Hose Company, the Friends of Old Dover, the Dover Rotary Club and the Delaware Historical Society.

He is survived by his wife, Julia K.; a sister, Mabel Short of Philadelphia, a stepson, Philip Baynard of New York, and one grandchild.

Services will be Friday afternoon at 2 at Christ Episcopal Church, Dover. There will be no viewing. Interment will be in the Christ Church cemetery. In lieu of flowers, the family suggests contributions be made to favorite charities.
