Irving was active in banking 1929 to 1968. He was assistant vice president of the Delaware Trust Company, Dover Branch, and in 1979 was awarded a 50 year achievement award. He was a graduate of Goldey Beacom Business College, and in 1959 graduated from Rutgers University School of Banking with a masters in banking.

He married Clara Delene Reed in Maryland on February 9, 1930, and they had two children.

DOVER — H. Irving Buckson, a former assistant vice president of the Delaware Trust Co.'s Dover office and a former Kent County prothonotary, died of an aneurysm Thursday in Kent General Hospital. He was 77.

Mr. Buckson, of 727 N. Governors Ave., began his 50-year banking career in 1929 as an assistant manager at the Dover office of Delaware Trust Co. Having also served as manager there, he was promoted to assistant vice president in 1959. He held that position until he retired in 1968. He then continued in an advisory position with Delaware Trust Co. for 11 years.

He was elected to a four-year term as Kent County prothonotary in 1968.

He was a past vice president of the Delaware Bankers Association.

He was a graduate of Dover High School, Goldey Wilmington Commercial College, and the Graduate School of Banking at Rutgers University, New Brunswick, N.J.

He was a member of Christ Episcopal Church, and served on the vestry of the church, and was a member of Robbins Hose Company of Dover.

He is survived by his wife, Clara R.; a son, Gerald I. of Wilmington; a daughter, Suzanne R. Crowder of Farmington, Conn.; a sister, Elizabeth B. Turner of Dover; six grandchildren and a great-granddaughter.

Memorial services will be at 11 a.m. Tuesday in Christ Episcopal Church, State and Water streets, Dover.
