G. Gordon Cockburn dies at 57

DOVER—G. Gordon Cockburn, 57, of 511 Greenhill Road, Dover, died yesterday in Delaware Hospital, Wilmington, after a long illness.

He would have been 58 on Wednesday.

Mr. Cockburn, president of the consulting engineering firm of Y Cobel, Inc., of Dover, was a life resident of the Dover area and instrumental in building and planning many municipal improvements in the state.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Ellen G. Cockburn; a son, G. Gordon Cockburn Jr. of Dover; a daughter, Mrs. Emmy Lou Austin of Dover, and two grand-children.

Services will be Monday afternoon at 2 in Christ Episcopal Church, Dover. Burial will be in Christ Church Yard.

There will be no viewing. The family has requested that flowers be omitted, and contributions made to the Delaware Cancer Society.
