DR. CALVIN C. COLE DIES IN HOME OF FRIENDS HERE

Dr. Calvin C. Cole, aged 50 years, died at the home of friends, Mr. and Mrs. John W. Kellum, of Gordon Heights, early Tuesday morning. He was the son of the late Amos Cole, former sheriff of Kent county, and was a well-known veterinarian. He had been ill but two days, though he had been in poor health for some time. He had an office at 919 Market street.

The body was taken to Dover yesterday, and the funeral will be held from the residence of his brother, Mark W. Cole, clerk of the Orphans Court of Kent county, at 2 o'clock this afternoon. Interment will be made in Price Episcopal cemetery, Dover.
