She was chairman of the board of Brunschwig Fils, a New York textiles firm its fabrics, known for wallpaper and art reproductions.

grew up in Rock Island, daughter of Dr. and Mrs. Joseph Comegys. Her father was a physician at Rock Island Arsenal.

After graduating Rock Island High School, she began her career as a fabric designer in 1929. In 1938 she married Roger Brunschwig, whose family had been in the textile business for 85 years.

Mrs. Brunschwig in 1951 was awarded the Legion of Honor by France for her contributions to that nation during and after World War II.
