DOVER, Feb. 26.—In Christ Episcopal Church at 4:30 o'clock this afternoon Miss Minnie Ferguson Bice, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. David Rodney Bice and Mr. Eric Finsen, son of Mr. and Mrs. Eyvind Finsen, will be married. The Rev. Paul A. Kellogg will officiate.

The bride, who will be given in marriage by her father, will wear a gown of antique-ivory satin, featuring a fitted bodice with an off-shoulder neckline embroidered in tiny seed pearls, long tapering sleeves and a full skirt to form a long circular train. Her veil of family heirloom lace will be draped in a mantilla effect falling over her shoulders to form a short cape. She will carry a white orchid with a shower of bouvardia on her white prayer book.

Mrs. James W. Flewellen will be matron of honor for her sister. The bridesmaids will be Miss Thelma Louise Finsen, sister of the bridegroom, and Miss Margaret Moore Thomson of Wynnwood, Pa., cousin of the bride. They will wear gowns of copper-tone bengaline. Wreaths of yellow daisies in their hair will match the flowers in the spring baskets which they will carry. They will wear short yellow gloves.

Miss Patricia Louise Attix of Wilmington, cousin of the bride, will be flower girl. She will wear a dress of white organdy over yellow satin, and carry yellow daisies.

Mr. Arnold N. Spicer of Seaford, will be best man. The ushers will be Mr. James B. Bice III of Dover, cousin of the bride; Mr. Crawford Carroll of Dover, and Mr. James W. Flewellen of Fredericksburg, Va.

The bride's mother will wear a gown of grey lace and crepe with matching straw hat trimmed in pink flowers. She will wear pink gloves and carry a bag with small pink roses attached. Mrs. Finsen will wear aqua crepe and lace with brown accessories and brown hat trimmed in roses. She will carry a brown faille bag with pink roses.

A reception will follow the ceremony at the Mapledale Country Club.

The bride is a graduate of Dover High School and attended Pine Manor Junior College, Wellesley, Mass., and Harcum Junior College, Bryn Mawr, Pa.

Mr. Finsen is a graduate of the Dover High School. He served with the Army and attended the U. S. Naval Academy Preparatory School at Bambridge, Md., and Wesley Junior College of Dover.

After a short wedding trip the couple will make their home in Dover.
