Dover, March 25.—The funeral of Caroline Barrett Ford, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harry F. Ford, of the Bayard House, took place here this morning at 11 o'clock in Christ P. E. Church, of which the deceased was a member. Services were conducted by the Rev. George Murray Bond, rector of Christ P. E. Church. The honorary pall bearers were State Senator Simson Pennewill, T. Victor Clarke, Townsend Smithers, James Allee, Herbert Jones, Marvel Gooden, Perch Holliday, Hayes Wilson, Walter Baker, Fleming Holliday, Carl Fleming and Walter Cariss.

**Death of Miss Carrie Ford.**

DOVER, Del., March 22.—Miss Carrie Ford, the only daughter of Proprietor Harry P. Ford, of the Bayard House, died to-day after a week's illness, of meningitis, caused by an attack of typhoid pneumonia. Dr. E. C. Anderson of Dover, the attending physician, called Dr. Thomas C. Moore of Smyrna, and Dr. Pressley S. Downs in consultation and on Wednesday Dr. Bartlett, of the Hahnemann Hospital, came to Dover to make an examination of the case. Dr. Downs stated that if the young woman recovered she would either be a cripple or an invalid.

Miss Ford was about 16 years of age and was probably one of the best-known young women of Dover. Her mother, Mrs. Ford, is prostrated by the death of her daughter, and Miss Amy Ford, an aunt, is ill with grip, and John M. Ford, the grandfather, is also ill at the Bayard House.
