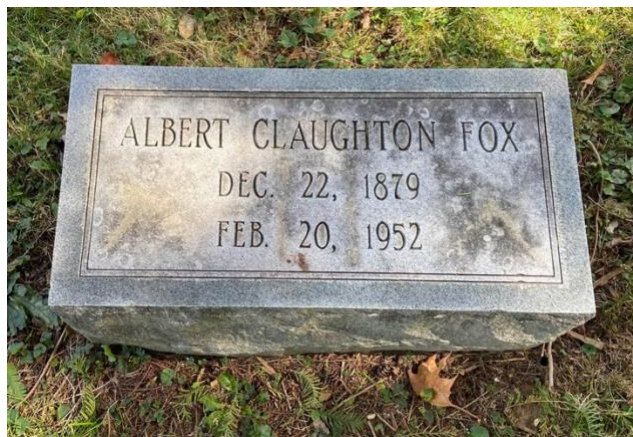

Albert C. Fox, 73, Retired Importer

Centerville, Md. — Albert Cloughton Fox, 73, a retired importer and English-born authority on metaphysics, died suddenly yesterday at his home, Headlong Hall Farm.

Born and raised in Woodford England, where he was a school chum of Winston Churchill, Fox early became interested in the study of metaphysics. He was a member of the British Metaphysics Society and had presented numerous papers received by the organization.

At the turn of the century, Fox founded an import firm with offices on Wall St.
