tended—The Glee Club.**

DOVER, April 17.—The funeral of Amelia Gibson, daughter of Rev. Lewis W. Gibson, which took place yesterday at 11 a. m., was very largely attended, especially by young people, and the floral offerings from the various associations to which the young lady belonged, were very handsome and profuse. The students of the academy turned out in a body, and the Sunday schools of nearly every church in town were largely represented. Bishop Coleman conducted the funeral services, assisted by Rev. Messrs. Littell of Wilmington, Dame of Smyrna, Carr of Milford, and Dr. Hamel of Dover.
