KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, John A. Greenwood and Miss Belle Matthews are held and firmly bound to the State of Delaware, in the sum of two hundred dollars, lawful money of the said State, to be paid to the said State of Delaware; to which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and each of us, jointly and severally, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated this 29th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 75.

The Condition of the above written Obligation is such, That if John A. Greenwood aforesaid and Miss Belle Matthews may lawfully unite themselves in marriage, and if there be no legal objection to celebrating the rites of marriage between them, then this obligation shall be void: otherwise, to be and remain in force.
