MRS. LUCY T. HARRISON DEAD IN JOHNSTOWN, PA.

Mrs. Lucy Turner (Vinson) Harrison died Wednesday, May 9, at 3 p. m., at the home of her daughter, Lucy, 907 Ash street, Johnstown, Pa. She was in her 66th year. Her health had been impaired for some time, but she died very unexpectedly, due to heart failure. Her illness was not considered serious, so her death was a shock to her family and friends. She is survived by her daughter, Lucy, married to Ernest Mitchell, also two grandsons and her son, Clayton Harrison, Jr., 909 Ash street, Johnstown, and a sister, Mrs. N. J. Devlin. Mrs. Harrison had been a member of St. Mark's Episcopal Church, Johnstown. Her body was taken to Christ Church, Dover, of which she was a member in her younger life. Interment was made on Friday morning in the family plot. Rev. B. F. Thompson of Christ Church conducted burial services.

The Harrison family resided many years in Wilmington and will be remembered by some of the older residents of the city.
