Age 51, of Wyoming, DE died Sunday May 12, 2002 in his home after an amazing battle with cancer while being surrounded by his wife, friends, and his best friend, Baxter.

He was born in Dallas, TX, the son of the late John F. Herrick and Sarah (Sally) Harrington Herrick.

Dan served in the Merchant Marines. He was an electronic technician for HiFi Service Center and Sound Studio. He was a sound technician for the Lost Orphans for many years.

He went cross-country 3 times on a Harley-Davidson and to the Sturgis Rally. He was a member of the Antique Automobile Club of America, the Jaguar Club of America, the Delaware Valley Region Classic Car of America, and the Nations Capital Jaguar Owners Club. He owned a 1959 Jaguar of which there were only 888 made. He was also a lifetime member of the American Blade Collectors and an avid collector of custom-made knives.

He is survived by his wife of 21 years, Joyce M. Breasure-Herrick; 1 sister, Sarah Naradzay of Aberdeen, NC; 2 brothers, John H. Herrick of Sydney, Australia and Michael Herrick of Gibson Island, MD; 2 sister-in-laws, Joan and Peg Breasure both of Georgetown; 1 niece, Catherine Naradzay of Aberdeen, NC; his faithful dog, Baxter; and a host of friends and family.
