DEATH OF MRS. HISS.

**Aged Seventh Ward Woman Passes
Away at Home of Faithful Friends.**

Mrs. **Elizabeth Hiss**, who for the past twelve years has been making her home with the family of Chief of Police Edward McCarey, 517 West Third street, died early this morning from the infirmities of old age. She had been ill for a long time, and her wants, so far as possible, had been supplied by the members of the McCarey family, although they were not related by the ties of nature.

So far as known Mrs. **Hiss** leaves no relatives in this section of the country, but a son is said to be living in the southwestern portion of the United States, although nothing has been heard of him for several years. Mrs. **Hiss** was a sister to the late Joseph Jeanes, the photographer, who died several years ago. The funeral will be in charge of Funeral Director Thomas J. Crumbie.
