FOUND DEAD IN BED AT HOME IN DOVER

DOVER, July 8—Mrs. Alice Hoey, 72 years old, widow of Robert J. Hoey, was found dead in bed yesterday morning, apparently from a heart attack. She had been active all day Friday and was about town on various errands and appeared to be in health when she retired for the night. When she failed to appear at her usual hour, yesterday morning, a member of the family went to her bed room and found her dead.

She is survived by her mother, Mrs. Mary Coates, who is more than 90 years old, and the following children: Clayton Hoey, of Penn's Grove, N. J.; William F. Hoey, of Providence, R. I.; Amanda G. B. Hoey, of Newport, R. I.; Mrs. A. C. Fox, of Glandon, L. I.; Edwin Hoey, of Chillicothe, O.
