Mr. Miller will give his daughter in marriage.

The bride's only attendant will be her twin sister, Mrs. Osborne R. Quayle of Atlanta, Ga., as matron of honor. Major William F. Hoey of Providence, R. I., a brother of the bridegroom, will be best man. The ushers will be: Dr. Osborne R. Quayle of Atlanta, Edward Reynolds Barnard of Whiting, Ind.; Charles A. Nutter of Philadelphia and Thomas Lodge of Washington.

There will be no reception following the ceremony, but a wedding supper will be served to a few relatives and close friends. After the marriage, Mr. Hoey and his bride will be at home at 127 Eastern avenue, S. E., Grand Rapids.

Tevis M. Hoey, 95, formerly of North High St., died 8:40 p.m. Tuesday, February 14, 1995, in Westmoreland Place.

She was born Aug. 31, 1899, in St. Louis, Mo., to George Brooke and Zaidee Tennent Miller. She was married in 1926, to Edwin A. Hoey, who died in 1970.

Surviving are sons and daughters-in-law, Brooke and Florence Hoey, St. Louis, Mo., Edwin Anderson "Ted" Jr. and Carole Clew Hoey, Middletown, Conn., Tennent and Marcia Hoey, Chillicothe; grandchildren, Richard Hoey, Charles Hoey, and Margaret Birnbaum, Ned Hoey, Lesley Hoey, and Ben Hoey, Bill Hoey, and Liz Hoey; great-grandchildren, Stephen Hoey and Sarah Birnbaum, Joseph and Peter Hoey; her twin sister, Zaidee T. Quayle, Easton, Md.; and several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by sisters, Margaret Ferguson and Florence Miller.

Mrs. Hoey was an active member in St. Paul's Episcopal Church, where she taught Sunday School, and had participated in the church choir for over 40 years.
