Services for H. Vance Holloway Jr., 55, of E. Country Club Lane, Wallingford, Pa., will be Monday at 2 p.m. in Christ Episcopal Church, Dover, with interment in the adjoining cemetery.

He died Thursday in Crozier Hospital, Chester, after a five-week illness.

He was the son of Dr. Harry V. Holloway, Dover, retired state superintendent of public instruction.

Mr. Holloway was personnel manager of the Catalytic Construction Co., Philadelphia.

He was born in New Castle and educated at Bordentown, N.J., Military Academy, and Springfield, Mass., College. He served at one time as assistant football coach at the University of Delaware.

Mr. Holloway was a member of the Media Lions Club and Masons.
