DOROTHY BEHLING HOWE, 80, of **Dover,** died Thursday in Kent General Hospital.

In 1980, Mrs. Howe retired to Dover from her native New York City. She was a member of Christ Episcopal Church, Dover, of which her son, the Rev. Gregory M. Howe, is rector.

In New York, Mrs. Howe was assistant to the director of Jewish Memorial Hospital for many years and a vestryman at St. Ignatius' Episcopal Church.

Her husband, James W. Howe, is deceased.

A Requiem Eucharist will be offered at 11 a.m. Thursday in Christ Episcopal Church, State and Water streets, with burial in the church cemetery.
