

Dover Nov. 28.—Christ Church was the scene or a notable wadding this afternoon, when Charles A. Hughes, D. D. S., of Mashington and Miss Helen Bishop, daugater of Dr. and Mrs. L. A. H. Bishop were married by the Rev. George M. Bond, the rector of the chorch. A ring was used in the veremony. The wedding party entered the church at 2.30 o'clock, to the strains of the wedding chorus from "Lohengria." sung by a quartet composed of Mrs. Harry F. Ford, Miss Clara Clarke, Wilham Pennewill and John Carrow, with Mrs. William Pennewill presiding at the organ. Owen Hendly of Washington was best man, and Miss Dora Wilds maid of Monor. Connor Akin and Dr. Hackyne of Washington, H. Ridgely Harrington and Frank C. Smith were ushers. The bride was given away by her father. She was gowned in white satin, and carried a white prayer-book. Miss Wilds was costumed in silk organdy, and carried Mareschal Neil roses. The church was handsomely decorated, and the attendance was large.

The bridal supper was served last night.
