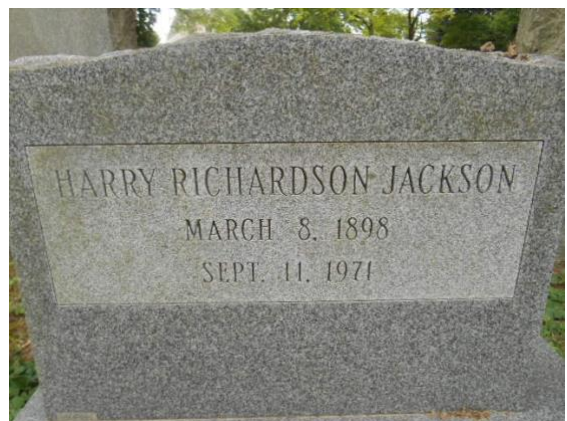

Ex-ILC Executive H. R. Jackson Dies

DOVER—Harry R. Jackson, 73, of 144 Kings Highway, suffered a fatal heart attack Saturday while playing in a golf tournament at the Maple Dale Country Club.

Mr. Jackson retired in 1967 as corporate safety director of International Latex Corp., which he joined in 1953 as an administrative assistant for personnel problems in the industrial relations division. He previously had worked as operations manager of the Coty, Inc., plant near Dover, as manager of the Unemployment Compensation Commission's Dover office from 1937 - 1951, and as a fruit broker.

He was a native of Dover. He played professional baseball with the Martinsburg, W. Va., team and professional football with the Millville, N.J., team. He was once president of the country club where he died.

Mr. Jackson served on Dover's City Council from 1960-1970. He had been a director of the Governor's Committee for Employment of the Physically Handicapped and a member of the Delaware Safety Council, the State Forestry Commission and the Tree Committee of Dover.

He is survived by his wife, the former Isabel Hope, a stepson, William J. Hughes, and a sister, Mrs. Hiram B. Donoho, all of Dover.

Services will be tomorrow at 2 p.m. in Christ Episopal Church, Dover, with interment in the church cemetery. There will be no viewing. The family asks that flowers be omitted.
