JON H. JAMISON, 78, formerly of Dover, died Tuesday of heart failure in Westminster Village Nursing Home, McKee Road, **Dover**, his residence for about six months.

Mr. Jamison, a roofing and heating contractor in the Dover area, retired in 1978.

He was a member of Christ Episcopal Church, Kiwanis Club of Dover and Robbins Hose Company of Dover.

He was a volunteer at Kent General Hospital, Dover.

His wife, Louise, died in 1980. Surviving are two sons, Jon E. of Washington, D.C., and Charles D. of Dover; and three grandchildren.

Memorial services will be at 11 a.m. Saturday in Christ Episcopal Church, State and Water streets, Dover.
