

Archibald Robert King, a brick layer living on Main Street, (State Street), Dover, married Marian (Mary) Emma Marvel. Joseph M. Clark of the M.E. church officiated the marriage. (attachment #1)

1880 Census - lists Archibald, Mary and children. He was still listed as a brick layer for occupation.

They had three children:

Margaret Ella King (1872 - ??)

Thomas P. King (1875 - ??)

Enos King (1876 - 1919) - his brother, Thomas, signed off on the death certificate. (attachment #2)

02-01-1884 - Archibald married Sarah E. Simmons 2 years after Mary died. Marriage certificate shows it was the second marriage for him. James Trickett, of the Baptist church officiated the marriage. The marriage record lists George H. Simmons and Mary A. Irons as the bride's parents. (attachments #3a, 3b)

The 1900 census shows a widowed Sarah E. King living alone on Bradford Street. (attachment #4)

Because Sarah married Archibald in 1884, she could not possibly be the person buried in 1882 in the churchyard. I believe the person buried in 1882 was Archibald's first wife, Marian (Mary) Emma Marvel King. I wonder who the others are? I really couldn't find any information on any of the other family members other than Enos died in Philadelphia and Thomas, his brother signed the death certificate.
