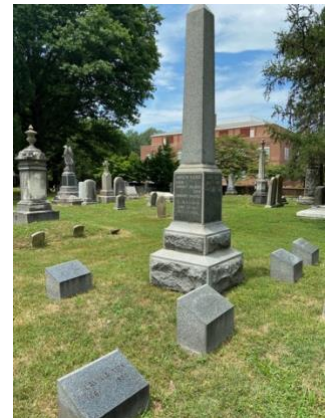

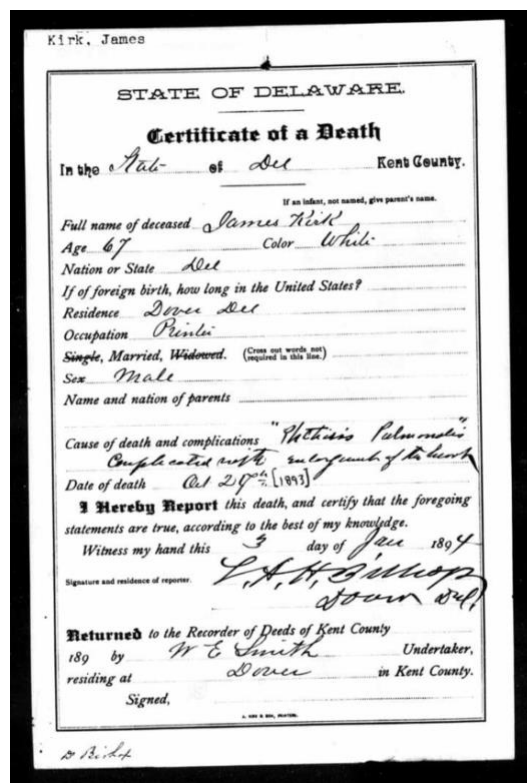
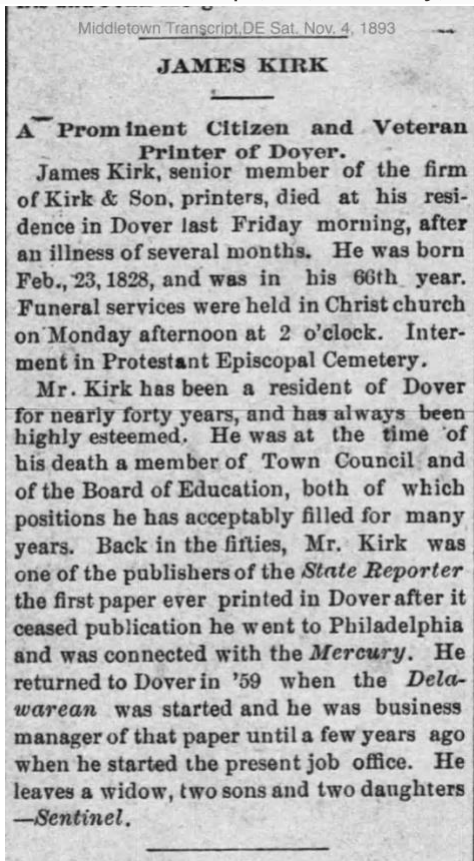
Marriage Certificate
