DOVER — Services for Delaware Sports Hall-of-Famer Edward "Pat" Knight, 76, who died Sunday in Kent General Hospital, will be Friday at 2 p.m. in Trader Funeral Home, 12 Lotus St.

Mr. Knight, of 1001 S. State St., was responsible for starting Little League baseball in Delaware.

He is survived by his wife, Anna; three brothers, William S. of Media, Pa., Clyde B. of Dover, and Milton S. of Forestville, Conn.; and a sister, Elizabeth A. Wright of Dover.

# Famed Delaware sportswriter dies

DOVER, Del. (AP) — Edward "Pat" Knight, a sports writer who started Little League Baseball in Delaware, died Sunday afternoon of complications from pneumonia. He was 76.

Knight, who was inducted into the Delaware Sports Hall of Fame in 1981, spent 30 years as a Little League volunteer.

He was a sports correspondent for 26 years for the News-Journal newspapers and served for 35 years in the Delaware National Guard before retiring as a warrant officer in 1969.
